

WHEREAS, federal and state funding is allocated to communities and decisions are made on matters of local and national importance based, in part, on census data and housing; and



3. Support census takers in their effort to complete and accurate count of Hockley County citizens.





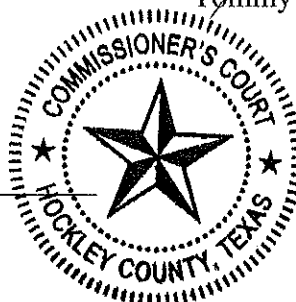
