Notice About 2022 Tax Rates

Property tax rates in HOCKLEY COUNTY.

This notice concerns the 2022 property tax rates for HOCKLEY COUNTY. This notice provides information about two tax rates used in adopting the current tax year's tax rate. The no-new-revenue tax rate would impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. In most cases, the voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

Voter-Approval Tax Rate Adjustments

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

The HOCKLEY COUNTY spent \$257,932 from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 on enhanced indigent health care at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$62,136. This increased the voter-approval tax rate by 0.001963/\$100.

This notice contains a summary of actual no-new-revenue and voter-approval calculations as certified by , on 08/05/2022 .

DATA EXTRACTION AND DISSEMINATION AGREEMENT

DEFINITIONS:

“**Digital Content**” is CLIENT’S data, images and/or videos as described in ‘Attachment A’

“**Extractions**” is the labor of events in which digital content is extracted on behalf of CLIENT’S request and is not defined in terms of quantity, dissemination methods or storage devices

“**Governing Body**” is the governing body that has the authority to exercise governance over an organization or political entity whose authority is to make binding decisions in a given geopolitical system

This document serves as a formal agreement between Hockley County, TX (hereinafter referred to as “CLIENT”) and i3 Bearcat, LLC (NET Data Corporation) (“NET Data”). CLIENT has requested that NET Data extract and deliver CLIENT’S digital content which resides on NET Data’s Virtual Hosted system to CLIENT. CLIENT understands and agrees that its digital content includes, but is not limited to, regulated data, and shall be disseminated by the requirements set forth in all applicable Federal and/or State laws. CLIENT further agrees to the following:

1. TERMS OF DELIVERY

1.1 DIGITAL CONTENT EXTRACTION AND DISSEMINATION REQUESTS

- 1.1.1 Once the data has been extracted and/or disseminated to the CLIENT, NET Data is not responsible for CLIENT’S digital content from the above-named. The CLIENT requests digital content for the content description and departments as stated in ‘Attachment A’.
- 1.1.2 NET Data will provide CLIENT ² extraction(s) as defined in this agreement’s definitions at the cost of \$ 5,000. Digital content extractions and dissemination requests shall not be performed until all monetary funds as described in this agreement have been received by NET Data.
- 1.1.3 The data extract will be provided in a csv delimited flat file format and may be either single or multiple files. In addition, a file layout will be provided to define the fields within each generic flat file format. ‘Attachment B’ contains a sample of the data extraction file and file layout as described in this section.
- 1.1.4 Images and/or Video extractions will be provided in the format in which they were received and shall include an index file. ‘Attachment C’ contains a sample of the images and/or video file extractions as described in this section.
- 1.1.5 The image and video index file will be provided in flat file format and shall correspond and include page counts of the extracted images and/or videos. ‘Attachment C’ contains a sample of the image and video index file as described in this section.
- 1.1.6 Digital content will be extracted to industry standard external storage devices or disseminated via SFTP to CLIENTS owned SFTP server. If storage devices named in this section are used, they shall be billed to CLIENT or purchased by CLIENT and sent to NET Data.
- 1.1.7 Digital content extracted to storage devices named in section 1.1.6 shall be disseminated to the governing body of the CLIENT.
- 1.1.8 Digital content extracted to storage devices named in section 1.1.6 shall be encrypted, and the encryption key shall be disseminated to the governing body of the CLIENT via email.


