Amendment No. 1

Conduent Government Records Services, Inc.

Hockley County, Texas

This first amendment ("Amendment No. 1"), to the Agreement for Information Technology Products and Services dated March 23, 2015 ("Agreement") is made by and between **Conduent Government Records Services, Inc.**, 8600 Harry Hines Blvd., Dallas, TX 75235 (formerly Government Records Services, Inc.) ("Conduent") and **Hockley County**, 802 Houston Street, Suite 210, Levelland, TX 79336 ("Client"). Conduent and Client (each individually a "party" and collectively, the "parties") agree as follows:

1. This Amendment No. 1 is effective on July 14, 2017 ("Amendment Effective Date").
2. Under Schedule A (Statement of Work), Section A (Scope of Services), the following are added as paragraphs 14, 15, and 16 under "Conduent Responsibilities":
 14. Conduent will provide to Penterra Services one (1) digital image of the documents filed with Client for the period from January 1, 1957 through December 31, 2017 that are in the Conduent database and one (1) digital copy of all related updated indexed information.
 15. Conduent will provide to Immersion Global one (1) digital image of the documents filed with Client for the period from January 1, 1945 through December 31, 2017 that are in the Conduent database and one (1) digital copy of all related updated indexed information.
 16. Conduent will provide to Client (or to any third party designated in writing by an authorized representative of Client) a digital image or images of all updated index information and digital images of the documents filed during the prior month or any combination of months, as requested in writing by Client. Client will notify Conduent in writing of the number of groups of digital images to be delivered (or made available for download) by Conduent to Client or each designated third party each month, as well as any changes to the number of groups of images to be delivered. Client will also notify Conduent whether Client or a designated third party will be responsible for the fee associated with each group of digital images being provided by Conduent.

3. As of the Amendment Effective Date, under Schedule A (Statement of Work), Section C (Payment and Rates), the following are added as new rows to the table of Services and Prices:

Digital Images – Provide digital images of real property documents and updated index information to Client or third parties designated in writing by Client.	\$91.00/per month for each group of digital images

4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as modified by this Amendment No. 1, shall remain in full force and effect.

Re: Imposition of Optional Fees for Calendar Year 2018

Your Honor:

County commissioners courts are statutorily required to notify the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) each year regarding the imposition or removal of optional fees. Notice must be made to the TxDMV each year by September 1 with new fees taking effect each year on January 1. This letter and attachments will provide information on how to submit the calendar year 2018 notification to the TxDMV. The following is a brief description of the local optional fees from Chapter 502 of the Transportation Code:

County Road and Bridge Fee (Section 502.401):

- may not exceed \$10;
- fees collected must be credited to the county road and bridge fund.

Child Safety Fee (Section 502.403):

- may not exceed \$1.50;
- revenue must be used for school crossing guard services; remaining funds must be used for programs to enhance child safety, health, or nutrition, including child abuse intervention and prevention and drug and alcohol abuse prevention.

Transportation Project Fee (Section 502.402) applies to Bexar, Cameron, El Paso, Hidalgo, and Webb counties only:

- may not exceed \$10 or \$20 for those meeting population requirements under Section (b) and (b-1);
- revenue must be used for long-term transportation projects.



PASSENGER VEHICLES / TRUCKS

6,000 lbs. or less = \$50.75

The annual registration fee for a passenger vehicle (including a motor bus or private bus) or truck with a gross vehicle weight of **6,000 lbs. or less is \$50.75**, plus applicable fees and local county fees.

Note: The gross vehicle weight of a truck is determined by adding the empty weight of the vehicle and the heaviest load that will be carried by the vehicle (carrying capacity) during the registration year.

TRAILERS / TRAVEL TRAILERS

6,000 lbs. and less = \$45.00

The annual registration fee for a trailer or travel trailer (if the trailer requires registration) with a gross vehicle weight of **6,000 lbs. or less is \$45.00**, plus applicable fees and local county fees.

ALL VEHICLES

6,001 lbs. – 10,000 lbs. = \$54.00

The annual registration fee for a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of **6,001 lbs. – 10,000 lbs. is \$54.00**, plus applicable fees and local county fees.

Note: The gross vehicle weight of a truck is determined by adding the empty weight of the vehicle and the heaviest load that will be carried by the vehicle (carrying capacity) during the registration year.

Upon receipt of the bills, Hockley County shall submit payment to the City of Ropesville within ten (10) days.

It is expressly understood and agreed that, in the execution of this Contract, neither party waives, nor shall be deemed hereby to waive, any immunity or defense that would otherwise be available to it against claims arising in the exercise of governmental powers and functions.
