



forth, said Petitioner, OCCIDENTAL PERMIAN, LTD., is hereby granted permission and authority to lay, construct, operate and maintain pipelines across certain county roads at the Exhibits "A" and "B" and application are hereby made a part of this order as fully as if set out in THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, subject to the conditions herein after set set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application of Petitioner herein, length herein provided.

- responsible for doing any work which, due to the existence of said pipelines undercrossings, needs to be done on said roads at the location thereof, all in order to maintain said roads, at such points, in a condition equal to other portions of said county roads. as said pipelines are maintained and operated under said roads Petitioner shall be m
- prior to such removal, all liability of Petitioner for the maintenance and reconditioning of such roads shall cease as soon after such removal as the COUNTY OF HOCKLEY has approved the Should Petitioner remove said pipelines from any of said roads, it will replace and recondition the road concerned, at the location of said removal, in substantially the same condition as it was maintenance and reconditioning work done by Petitioner. 4
- Assignee shall make such reasonable changes of its facilities located within such right of way as Petitioner agrees that if at any time the County of Hockley shall deem it necessary to make any roads which as located under this order, then and in such event, the Petitioner may be deemed necessary, such work to be done without cost to Hockley County, Texas. improvements or changes on all of or any part of the right of way of the county affect the Utility iń
