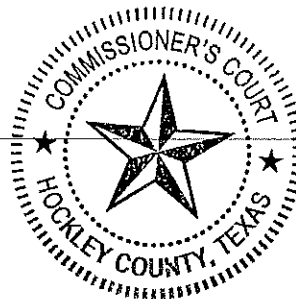

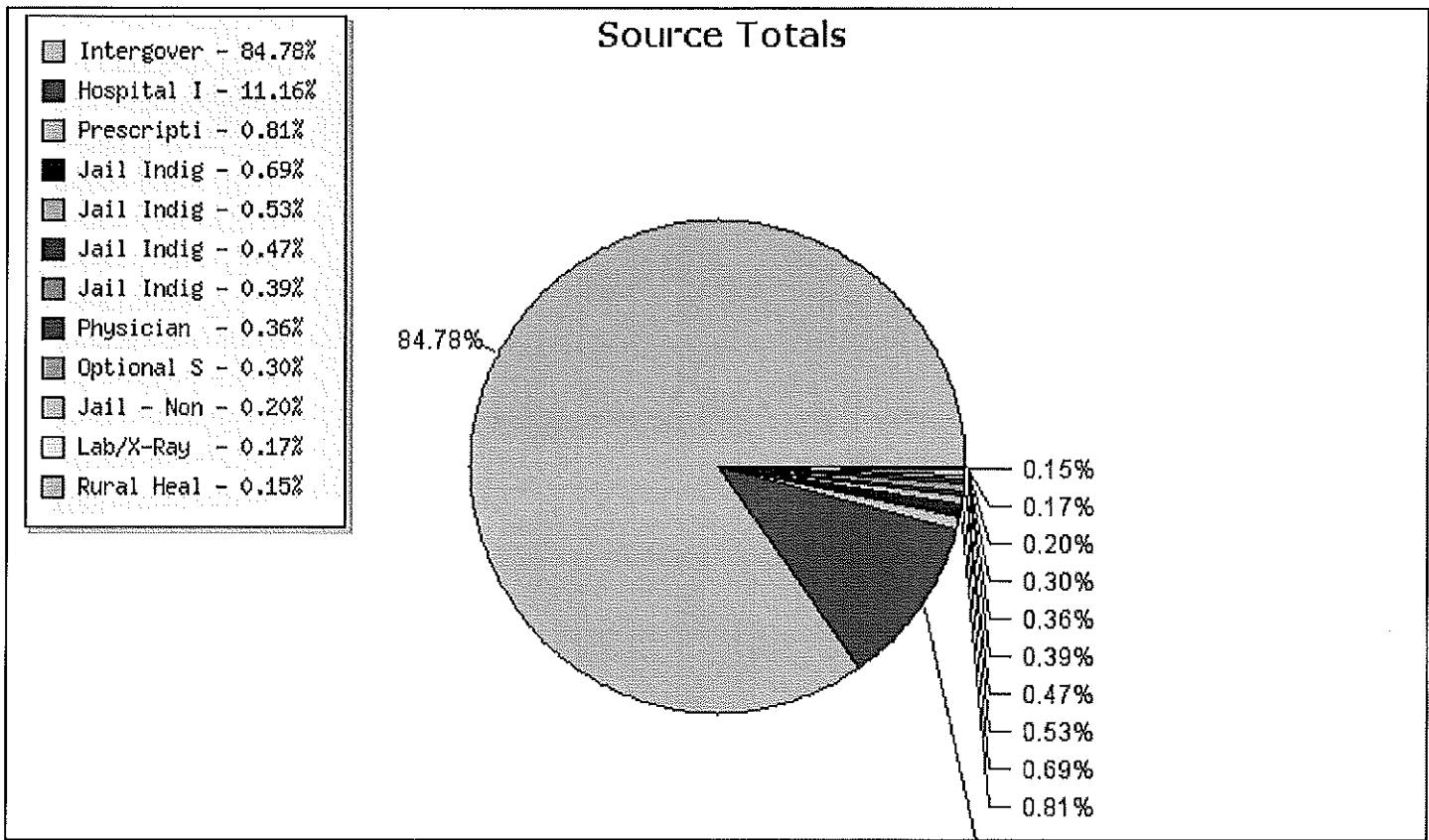

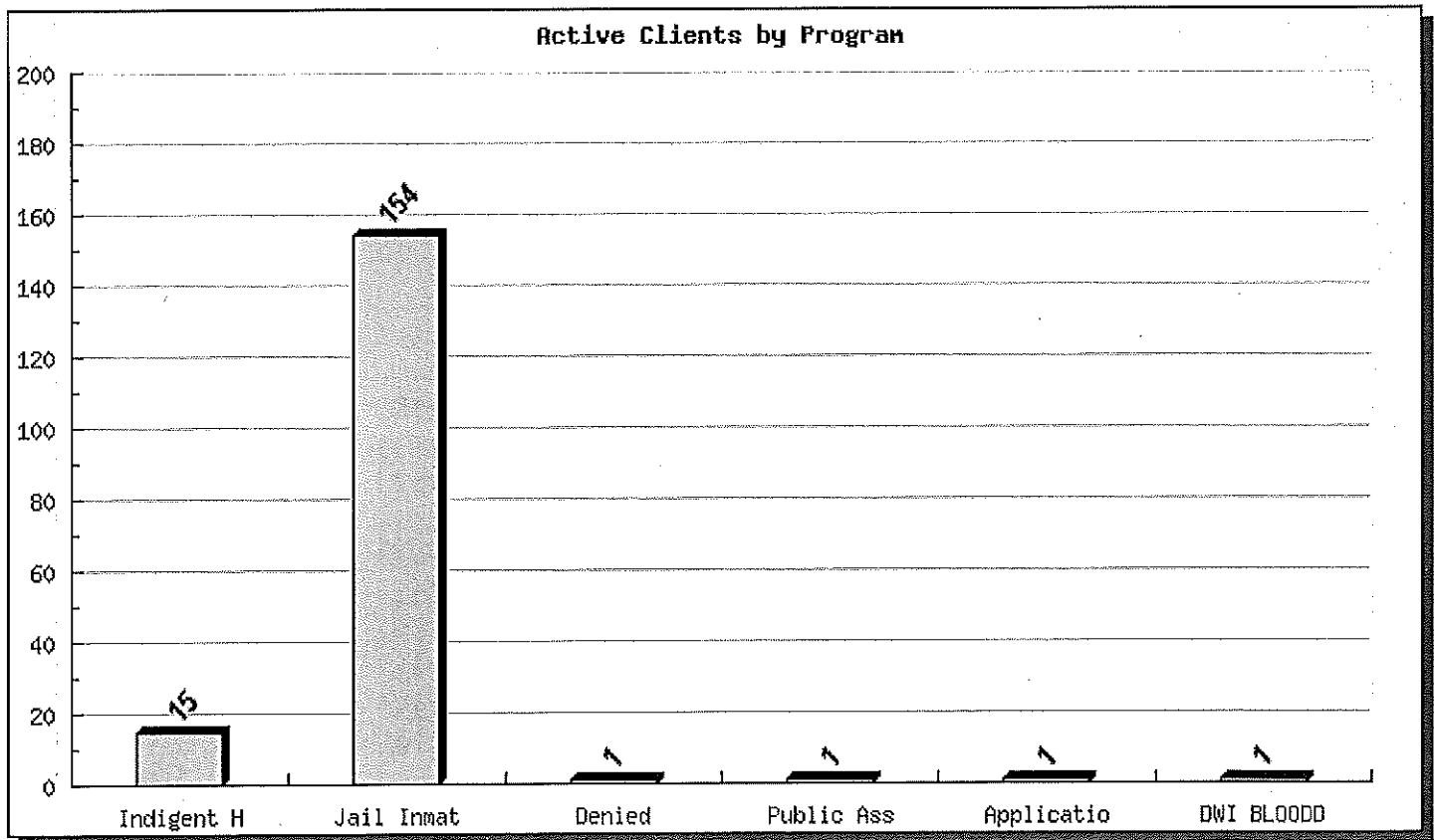

- Food Stamps
- Other unearned income
- Social Security
- Unemployment
- Bank Accounts
- Housing Payments to Landlords
- Contributions
- Worker's Compensation
- TANF
- Utility Reimbursements

The base amount for determining Public Assistance eligibility is 100% of the Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines which are recorded in the Federal Register.
