Task 2 – Onsite Air Monitoring

GiF will provide a TDSHS licensed Project Manager and Air Monitoring Technician or Individual Asbestos Consultant to perform on-site supervision for the duration of the project. GiF's proposed services during removal of ACM include:

- Review of abatement contractor's certificates, licenses and registrations necessary for compliance with the TAHPR
- Review of abatement contractor's practices for conformance with regulatory guidelines
- Baseline air sampling prior to project start
- Daily air monitoring during the duration of the project, necessary for compliance with the TAHPR

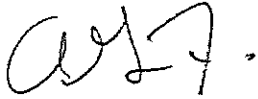

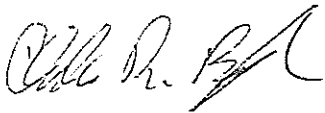

CLIENT AND CONSULTANT HAVE EVALUATED THE RISKS AND REWARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS PROJECT, INCLUDING CONSULTANT'S FEE RELATIVE TO THE RISKS ASSUMED, AND AGREE TO ALLOCATE CERTAIN OF THE ASSOCIATED RISKS. TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE TOTAL AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF CONSULTANT (AND ITS RELATED CORPORATIONS AND EMPLOYEES) TO CLIENT AND THIRD PARTIES GRANTED RELIANCE IS LIMITED TO THE GREATER OF \$25,000 OR CONSULTANT'S FEE, FOR ANY AND ALL INJURIES, DAMAGES, CLAIMS, LOSSES, OR EXPENSES (INCLUDING ATTORNEY AND EXPERT FEES) ARISING OUT OF CONSULTANT'S SERVICES OR THIS AGREEMENT. Invoices will be submitted to CLIENT by CONSULTANT and will be due and payable upon presentation. If CLIENT objects to any portion of any invoice, CLIENT will notify CONSULTANT in writing within fourteen (14) calendar days of the invoice date, identify the cause of disagreement, and pay when due that portion of the invoice not in dispute. The parties will immediately make every effort to settle the disputed portion of the invoice. In the absence of written notification described above, the balance as stated on the invoice will be paid. Invoices are considered delinquent if payment has not been received by CONSULTANT within thirty (30) days from date of invoice. CLIENT agrees to an administrative fee of 1.5% per day to be added for each invoice over 30 days, except any portion of the invoiced amount in dispute and resolved in favor of CLIENT. 6. The construction or laying of said steel conduit water lines by Petitioner hereunder shall be considered and shall constitute and acceptance of this order and of all of the terms and conditions herein set forth.
7. Petitioner agrees that if at any time the County of Hockley deems it necessary that these crossings be encased in accordance with the then existing State Highway specifications, Petitioner agrees to do so at its own expense.

Wherefore, your Petitioner respectfully prays that your Honorable Board enter and order herein authorizing Petitioner to use and occupy the portions of the roads in Hockley County, Texas, more particularly herein above set out and described and at the locations shown and set out in said Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to this application.
