





We are hoping to get them out mid-September but are unable to give a specific date.

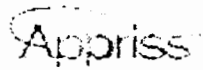


WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and






