

RESOLUTION 2021-11-11

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RESULTS AND DECLARING
THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021.

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the City of Smyer, Texas on the 2nd day of November, 2021, for the purpose of voting FOR or AGAINST the following:

"The legal sale of malt beverage and wine for off-premise consumption only."

"La venta legal de bebida de malta y vino para consumo solamente fuera del establecimiento."

and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made that there were cast at said election 85 valid and legal votes, that the local option to legalize received the following votes:

<u>Against</u>	10

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the City of Smyer, Texas on the 2nd day of November, 2021, for the purpose of voting FOR or AGAINST the following:

"A sales and use tax is adopted within the city at the rate of TWO percent"

"Se adopta un impuesto sobre las ventas y el uso dentro de la ciudad a una tasa del dos por ciento"

and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made that there were cast at said election 85 valid and legal votes, that the local sales and use tax option received the following votes:


<u>For</u>	71

That said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that both options passed at said election, subject to and as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the front door of City Hall, accessible to the general public and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.
